**DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION (REGULATION

Citation.

1. These By-Laws may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Regulation of Traffic on Dams) By-Laws.

Use of dams
without per-
mission an
offence.

2. Any person who uses any motor vehicle or hauls any log, timber, wood, padi, rice or any other agricultural products or plants by any means whatever on any dam without the permission in writing of the Drainage and Irrigation Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") or of any person authorised in that behalf by the

Drainage and Irrigation (Regulation of Traffic on Dams) By-laws

[Subsidiary]

Board shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of one hundred dollars.

3. The Board may erect gates or fences on any dam for the purpose of prohibiting or regulating traffic thereon.

Power to erect gates, etc.

4. Any person who unlawfully interferes with, removes, damages or destroys any gate or fence erected on any dam shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of one hundred dollars.

Damage to gates or fences an offence.

5. These By-Laws shall apply to all dams within any drainage and irrigation area.
