Veterinary Surgeons (Qualifications for Registration) Regulations, 1990

IT is hereby notified that the Council of Veterinary Surgeons, in terms of section 26, as read with section 48 of the Veterinary Surgeons Act [Chapter 227], and with the approval of the Minister of Lands, Agriculture and Rural Resettlement, has made the following regulations:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Veterinary Surgeons (Qualifications for Registration) Regulations, 1990.
- 2. The degree of Bachelor of Veterinary Science from the University of Zimbabwe is prescribed for the purpose of paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section 26 of the Act.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the regulations but is intended to explain their contents.)

The effect of these regulations is that persons who hold the degree of Bechelor of Veterinary Science from the University of Zimbabwe are qualified for registration under the Veterinary Surgeons Act [Chapter 227] without having to pass the local examinations prescribed and set by the Council of Veterinary Surgeons.
